Introducing two floor systems to solve your event problem

Adjustable Grid Flooring System (Up to 2 Metres High)

Fews can now provide an adjustable grid flooring system for 5 metre bay marquees which is adjustable and adaptable to different heights while maintaining stability. Thanks to the self-levelling system, which can be set between 0.2 and 2 meters, this floor can be installed in almost any location. It is multifunctional and complies with all dimensional criteria and allowable loads, offering numerous possibilities for use.

The key advantages are:

- Great for level floors with large variance up to 2m
- Weight loading to 500kg/m2
- Phenolic coated boards for low-slip performance
- Compatibility with ramps with grey powder coated and/or glass handrails
- Option for clear Perspex panels to replace timber
- Integrates with marquee frame and walling, eliminating water egress
- Easy to create multi-levels for raised platforms or sunken areas

This Innovative grid flooring system for 5m marquees can be provided with a unique stairs & handrail system.

- Platforms, ramps and step access
- Phenolic board or perspex flooring
- Glass and steel handrail options

Heavy Deck Floor System

When planning large events, the load bearing capacity is often an important factor. This is why heavy-duty floors are the perfect solution for marquees and large tents when extra weighting is needed.

Heavy duty floors consist of sturdy, durable steel frames with an anti-corrosion coating. Wood panels with a tongue and groove joint or a non-slip phenol-based layer are used as filling elements, achieving a load-bearing capacity of up to 500 kg/m².

- Perfect for quick install and removal
- Weight loading to 500kg/m2 phenolic coated boards for low-slip performance
- Can be self-weighting and avoid concrete ballast need (on certain size structures)

Forest Green Rovers FC Temporary Gym Facility.

- We provided a new, purpose-built marquee to house a gym, office and physio spaces
- Built on a level integrated floor system with thermo insulated ISO panel walls and thermo insulated PVC roofs to reduce energy consumption
- DDA compliant access ramps and platforms were used exterior to the marquee providing safe and inclusive access in and out of the marquee
- Worked with Forest Green design team to maximise suitability and user experience



Our Orangery structure was used for a brand activation event for a major company in Bedford.

To meet their requirements, we provided:

- 15m x 30m Orangery
- White PVC roof
- Clear PVC gable
- Cassette floor
- Oak vinyl flooring
- Weighted according to site specific calculations

Client Requirements:

The structure needed to offer:

- A high-end, visually impressive design consistent with Aston Martin's luxury brand image
- Ample space for hosting VIP guests
- A weather-resistant solution for the British summer, ensuring comfort regardless of the conditions



Challenges:

- High Standards: Aston Martin required a premium feel for both the exterior and interior to align with their reputation for excellence
- Weather Conditions: The unpredictable Silverstone weather demanded a robust, fully weatherproof environment

Solutions:

- A 25m x 42.5m clear span structure with a curved PVC roof was selected to meet the client's specifications
- The clear span design offered an open, pillar-free interior, maximizing usable space
- The curved PVC roof added a sleek, modern aesthetic, enhancing the structure's visual appeal
- High quality branded gable
- Full air conditioning
- Wrap around steps to transition from outside to inside
